






Overview

Nuclear energy; strategic plan for overall goal of carbon-free energy

Established by Legislation passed in February

Three elements the plan should include:

- Promotion of new technologies and opportunities for innovation; including advanced manufacturing;
- Establishment of a collaborative research center and university leadership program to promote education in fields that meet the workforce demands of Virginia's nuclear industry;
- Recognition of the role of nuclear energy in the Commonwealth's goal of employing 100
 percent carbon-free sources of energy by 2050

Report due October 1, 2020 and shall be updated every four years
